## **Henderson Executive Airport Security Measures\***

**Community Awareness:** The vigilance of airport users is one of the most effective methods of enhancing security at GA airports.

### **“See Something, Say Something”**

What to report:

- Suspicious activity or type of incident
- Aircraft tail number (if applicable)
- Physical appearance of suspicious person(s) (gender, height, clothing)
- Other relevant information

If you observe any suspicious activity or individuals loitering around aircraft, please report it immediately to the Airport Control Center at 702.261.5125, or call 911. Your watchfulness is crucial in preventing future incidents.

**Access Control and Safeguards:** The airport is monitored 24-hours a day by a CCTV camera system. Security fencing is in place around the airport perimeter, and ‘No Trespassing’ signage is posted along the perimeter fence line. If you should see an open gate or breach in the fence line, please report it immediately to airport personnel. All private vehicles operated on the Air Operations Area display a current Airport decal or are under escort of a tenant driving a vehicle with a current decal. Gate Cards cannot be loaned to others or used by anyone other than the authorized card holder.

**Armed Guard Patrols:** Contract security personnel are on site during the evening and overnight hours and conduct frequent and thorough patrols throughout the airport, particularly in areas with

parked aircraft. Additionally, Airport personnel have undergone security training and have passed a TSA background check.

**Collaboration with Law Enforcement:** The Department of Aviation has a mutual aid agreement in place with the Henderson Police Department to provide law enforcement assistance.

**Securing Aircraft:** Properly securing aircraft is the most basic method of enhancing GA airport security. Owner/operators should employ multiple methods of securing their aircraft to make it as difficult as possible for an unauthorized person to gain access to it.

**Airport security is shared responsibility of all airport users. The safety of airport tenants and property is a top priority, and we appreciate your cooperation as we work to address these security concerns.**
