## **North Las Vegas Airport Security Measures**

### **Access Control and Safeguards**

The North Las Vegas Airport (VGT) is monitored 24-hours, 7 days a week by a CCTV camera system. The airport perimeter includes six-foot chain-link fencing topped with three-strand barbed wire. In addition, 'No Trespassing' signage is posted along the perimeter fence line.

All private vehicles operated on the Air Operations Area must display a current airport decal or be under escort of a tenant driving a vehicle with a current decal. Gate access cards are issued to authorized individuals and cannot be loaned to others or used by anyone other than the authorized card holder. If you see an open gate or breach in the fence line, please report it immediately to airport personnel.

### **Armed Guard Patrols**

Contracted security personnel are on site during the evening and overnight hours and conduct frequent and thorough patrols throughout the airport, particularly in areas with parked aircraft. Additionally, airport personnel have undergone security training and have passed a federal background check.

### **Collaboration with Law Enforcement**

The Department of Aviation has a mutual aid agreement in place with the North Las Vegas Police Department to provide law enforcement at VGT as needed.

The Department of Aviation has implemented the above security measures, however airport security is a shared responsibility.

Report:

- Suspicious activity or type of incident
- Aircraft tail number (if applicable)
- Physical appearance of suspicious person(s) (gender, height, clothing)
- Other relevant information

### **Securing Aircraft**

Pilots and tenants are strongly encouraged to take the necessary precautions to secure their property, including locking and properly tying down aircraft, and properly locking hangars.
